

PUBLIC USE AREAS

Davis Lake has some waterfront 'streets and walkways' dedicated to "public use forever" [from the deed dated March 30, 1950]. That means access is open to anyone. From the plat map, these locations include the following:

- 1) The entire length of Davis Lake Laane, a 40-foot-wide road,
- 2) The 20-foot walkway between 251 Davis Lake Road and the lot that is vacant as of 6/5/2024,
- 3) The 20-foot walkway between 321 Davis Lake Road and 331 Davis Lake Road,
- 4) The 20-foot walkway between 461 Davis Lake Road and 471 Davis Lake Road.
